WARNINGS

- WITHHOLDING PERIOD:
 - Do not harvest edible crops within 7 days after application.

GENERAL INFORMATION

AXCELA® is readily ingested by snails and slugs. It is effective against most slugs and snails. Best results are achieved by application during mild and damp weather as well as after irrigation, when slugs and snails are most active, but when rain is not expected. In case of heavy snail or slug attack it may be necessary to repeat the application.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- Use restrictions:
- Do not apply heaps of bait.
 - Take care not to apply bait to edible parts of crops, where bait and crop can be harvested.
 - Late application of pellets to broad-leaved plants may result in lodging of pellets in foliage.
 - Do not apply when heavy rainfall is forecast.

AXCELA® slug pellets may be applied uniformly directly to the soil by mechanical fertilizer distributor or granule applicator Calibrate your applicator before use. Small areas may be treated by hand.

Crop/Pest	Application Rate	Recommendations
CROPS, GRAHARDS & VINES: Brown snail (<i>Helix aspersa</i>)	GROUND APPLICATION: 5–7 kg/ha	Apply as an even broadcast application on the row where snail activity is noticed. In Vines apply close to supportive struts as well. Repeat application if snail infestation re-occurs.
VINES: Dune snail (<i>Theba pisana</i>)	GROUND APPLICATION: 5–7 kg/ha	Apply as an even broadcast application onto ridges and around stems where snail activity is noticed, it is important to apply close to supportive struts as well. Repeat application if snail infestation re-occurs.
HORTICULTURE & GARDENS: Brown snail (<i>Helix aspersa</i>)	GROUND APPLICATION: 5–7 kg/ha	Bait should be scattered evenly in the flower beds where snail activity is noticed. Scatter evenly under all dense foliage, shrubs and trees. Where plants are in containers, place the bait close to the base of each container. Repeat application if snail infestation re-occurs.

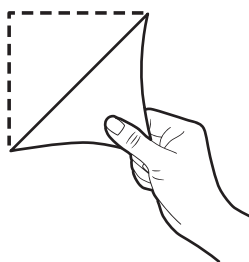
